

National Cheng Kung University Department of Mechanical Engineering Bachelor's degree Regulations

Article 1: Student Major in Department of Mechanical Engineering should take the Required Course in our department. Otherwise, it should go through administrative procedures to apply for approval.

Article 2: If taking the Electives Course need the prerequisite courses for the subject must be based on the minimum score set by the teacher.

Article 3: Students shall each enroll with 9 to 25 course credits per semester in each year of study. Students who are get 80 grades they can entitled to enroll with one or two additional courses, thus going beyond the maximum of 25 course credits.

Article 4: Elective courses should be taken at least 18 credits in Department of Mechanical Engineering. If the courses are not taught by the department it should go through administrative procedures to apply for approval. Double Major and Minor are following this Regulations.

Article 5: Dual degree and exchange student who take the credits from foreign country the credits awarded by the application is approved by the administrative procedures.

Article 6: Graduation requirements are totally 144 credits. Including 81 credits required, 28 credits of "general education courses" and 35 credits of electives.

Article 7: Physical education courses will not be counted as graduation credits but it's required courses.
